JESUS IS ALL

To understand who we believe Jesus is

For those who know Him have renewed confidence in Him

For anyone who doesn't yet know Him as Lord and Saviour to have an opportunity to do so

15 The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. 16 For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him.

17 He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. 18 And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy.

19 For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, 20 and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.

HEISTHEPOINT

So many live life asking 'what is the point?'

We all have an innate sense of transcendent reality and a sense of purpose beyond ourselves

Jesus has always been, is and always will be the point!

1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy our brother, 2 To God's holy people in Colossae, the faithful brothers and sisters in Christ: Grace and peace to you from God our Father

THANK GOD

Written from prison (debated time and location) where Paul (likely with Timothy) was held for preaching the gospel

Written to people he had not visited at a church that was planted (started) by his friend Epaphras

He starts the letter with a long prayer of thanks for the faith and love being lived out among them

3 We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, 4 because we have heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love you have for all God's people



PAUL THE POET

The purpose of writing was to address struggles with false teaching questioning the supremacy and deity of Jesus

Much of the letter is Paul's typical instructive manner but here he includes a 'poem' summing this Christological doctrine up for them (and us) in a memorable way

Lord Jesus: Creator and Redeemer of all

15 He is the exact living image [the essential manifestation] of the unseen God [the visible representation of the invisible], the firstborn [the preeminent one, the sovereign, and the originator] of all creation.

THIS IS ALL WE ALL NEED TO UNDERSTAND STILL TODAY

JESUS IS ALL

People want to know where we come from and how we came to exist - Jesus

People want to know what happens when we die and what the future holds - Jesus

He is the Alpha and the Omega (Revelation 1)

CHAPTER 1: JESUS WAS THE ALL FROM BEFORE THE BEGINNING - ALPHA

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning. 3 Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made.

JESUS THE ALPHA - "AXQa

In Genesis 1 God says 'Let US make humankind in our own image' - Jesus in creation

Before the beginning of time He was the Great I Am - the one who exists

We believe the world's existence is due to the creative will and love of the triune God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit

17 And He Himself existed and is before all things, and in Him all things hold together. [His is the controlling, cohesive force of the universe.

JESUS IS LORD

Jesus allowed others to worship Him as Lord (Matthew 2:11, Matthew 21:9, Matthew 14:33, Matthew 28:9)

Jesus in documented in John's Gospel as making 7 'I Am' statements about himself - a clear claim to be God

This was ultimately the claim and 'accusation' that saw Him crucified by the Sanhedrin and by Pilate

"Now there was about this time Jesus, a wise man, if it be lawful to call him a man; for he was a doer of wonderful works, a teacher of such men as receive the truth with pleasure. He drew over to him both many of the Jews and many of the Gentiles. He was [the] Christ. And when Pilate, at the suggestion of the principal men amongst us, had condemned him to the cross, those that loved him at the first did not forsake him; for he appeared to them alive again the third day; as the divine prophets had foretold these and ten thousand other wonderful things concerning him. And the tribe of Christians, so named from him, are not extinct at this day."

AND THE 'TRIBE OF CHRISTIANS' IS CERTAINLY STILL NOT EXTINCT!

STANDING THE TEST-IMONY OF TIME

Innumerable people's lives have testified to the power of God revealed in Christ - beginning with the first Apostles who nearly all died for their testimony and those here today

Our years and our annual calendar are shaped around the life of Jesus - His power at work in our weakness

2025 years (approximately) ago everything changed!

THE CREATOR STEPPED INTO HIS CREATION

14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

IT'S ALL ABOUT YOU, JESUS

The Word = The Logos = Jesus the Messiah

The incarnation, life, ministry, death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus of Nazareth are the crux of all history and reveal Him to be our ALL in ALL (Colossians 3:11)

His current place (within our concept of time) is as the head of His church - the source and life

18 He is also the head [the life-source and leader] of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that He Himself will occupy the first place [He will stand supreme and be preeminent] in everything.

CHAPTER 2: JESUS IS ALL IN THE NEW CREATION BEYOND THE END - OMEGA

20 and through [the intervention of] the Son to reconcile all things to Himself, making peace [with believers] through the blood of His cross; through Him, [I say,] whether things on earth or things in heaven.

JESUS PAID IT ALL

God dwelt among us in all His fullness - somehow both fully God and fully human - in order to reconcile us to Him

Our Lord and Saviour has not only revealed who He is through His word, He has revealed Himself as one of us

When Christ breathed His last upon the cross, He declared 'Tetelestai' - it is finished/accomplished/fulfilled - <u>all</u> done

21 Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of your evil behaviour. 22 But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation

JESUS GAVE ALL OF HIMSELF FOR YOU HE DESERVES OUR ALL

JESUS THE OMEGA-3Ω

One day we will <u>all</u> stand before the judgement seat of Jesus (Revelation 20:12)

He is the centrepiece of heaven and forever we will know that Jesus is all

There is salvation and eternal life for those who have trusted in Jesus and given Him their <u>all</u>

17 When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. Then he placed his right hand on me and said: 'Do not be afraid. I am the First and the Last. 18 I am the Living One; I was dead, and now look, I am alive for ever and ever! And I hold the keys of death and Hades.

JESUS IS ALL

Jesus was, is and always will be the centrepiece of creation

At Elim Aberystwyth we are seeking to be 'a people who are Christ-centred'

Is Jesus the centre of your life today?
