DELVING INTO THE PSALMS

The Psalms: a collection of ancient Hebrew poems, songs and prayers by various writers complied by the people of Israel some time after their exile in Babylon

Deliberately and cleverly collated into five different yet overlapping sections and themes

Served as a form of temple worship for the templeless people God

Transliteration: halal

Definition: To praise, to boast, to shine, to celebrate, to glory

HALLELUJAH

Halal, hallel, praise, celebrate, shine a light upon, glory in and boast about Yhwh!

The final five Psalms all have no title but all begin and end with this beautiful bookend!

Praise the Lord!

4 Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: rejoice!

AGAIN I SAY REJOICE

The Apostle Paul doubly implored the church in Philippi to rejoice - defeat anxiety and know peace

The psalmist implored the people of God to Hallel in a multiplicity of ways in these few verses!

Sing a new song, praise in the assembly, rejoice: dance & make music, sing for joy in your beds!

SING A NEW SONG

A new song... a testimony to what God has done in your life or His truth revealed to your heart

Do we want to bring God a 'hallmark greeting' or a handwritten message?

Express your unique relationship with Him, your unique words, your unique story

NOBODY ELSE CAN SING YOUR SONG OF PRAISE TO THE LORD

PRAISE IN THE ASSEMBLY

It is fantastic to sing your songs to The Lord in your own time and space but it is not enough

To know a fuller expression and experience of praise we need to do it together

Never underestimate the power of a praising and worshipping community

THERE IS LITTLE MORE POWERFUL THAN THE SOUND OF YAHWEH'S PRAISE EMANATING FROM A SUFFERING SISTER OR A BRUISED BROTHER

23 Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. 24 And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, 25 not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

I NEED TO HEAR YOUR SONG OF PRAISE, PLEASE DON'T DEPRIVE ME!

REJOICE: DANCE & MAKE MUSIC

Don't let anyone tell you that we should not have joyous music, dancing and celebration in church!

I call our meetings 'Sunday Celebrations' for a reason - even when we are fighting or grieving

The word 'service' not wrong but is ambiguous and the reason we gather is to encourage one another



Transliteration: machowl (maw-khole')

Definition: Dance

From chuwl; a (round) dance

STRONGS CONCORDANCE



DANCING MAY NOT BE YOUR THING, BUT TRY JOINING IN AND KEEPING THE SMILE OFF YOUR FACE!

SING FOR JOY IN YOUR BEDS!

When we know the joy of The Lord our singing cannot be confined to the assembly or the car

Our beds are often a place of contemplation and meditation - 'sleep on it'

Too often we dwell on worries and fears - what if we can turn them into songs of joy?

TAMBOURINES & HARPS WERE THE INSTRUMENTS OF THE DAY - DON'T BELIEVE ONLY ORGANS ARE VITAL!

THE WHY...

The Lord takes delight in His people (v4) and we sing, shout and dance because we are His joy

God default perspective toward us is not grumpy, angry and vindictive

Our delight in life flows from the fact that our creator delights in us - His people

HE CROWNS THE HUMBLE

God opposes the proud and gives grace to the humble - Proverbs 3:34, Psalm 138:6 and James 4:6

Christ is our ultimate picture of humility - the Lord of creation who to serve sacrifice His own life

He is The Father's delight and in Him we delight too

PRAISE IS A WEAPON

In the day of the psalmist, the battle was against the nations and their idols and abhorrent practices

We know according to the NT that our battle is spiritual and through the ministry of Christ that love is our answer to our enemies

The word of God is the sharpest weapon we can fight with!

8 to bind their kings with fetters, their nobles with shackles of iron, 9 to carry out the sentence written against them – this is the glory of all his faithful people.

THE JUDGEMENT OF GOD

Last week in Psalm 7 we were to remind ourselves that the Lord is just and we can trust His justice

From Psalm 2 we noted that there is 'no point standing against the Lord' and that He is our refuge

We are to stand and fight against injustice with the truth of God's word AND trust in His righteousness

THE JUDGEMENT OF GOD

Christ is the judge

Whether in this life or in eternity we will be absolutely satisfied in the righteousness of God and that the justice has been carried out

Paul, 1 Corinthians 6, introduces to the curious matter that we will be privileged to judge with Him

2 Or do you not know that the Lord's people will judge the world? And if you are to judge the world, are you not competent to judge trivial cases? 3 Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more the things of this life!

"Whatever that will look like, Paul's point here is that the Corinthian Christians are living as if this was not their destiny. They are acting as if they are incompetent to judge the smallest issue!"

LIVING AS THOSE WHO ARE TRANSFORMED BY AND WHO BELONG TO CHRIST HITS DIFFERENT!

RAISE A HALLELUJAH

We want our lives to be increasingly shaped by The sprit and the Living Word of The Lord

We are not going to be perfect but we are on a journey by grace upon grace from glory to glory

Which brings us back to bringing our Hallels to Yah!
