


DELVING INTO THE PSALMS

The Psalms are collection of ancient Hebrew poems, songs and prayers by various writers complied by the people of Israel some time after their exile in Babylon

They are deliberately and cleverly collated into five different yet overlapping sections and themes

PSALMS 1 & 2

Psalms 1 & 2 are distinct from 'Book 1' as they are anonymous, where the others are linked to David

Psalm 1 invites the <u>individual</u> (micro) to consider walking in the way of the godless or the ways of The Lord and His torah

Psalm 2 invites <u>nations & kings</u> (macro) to recognise The Lord, His plan, His authority and His Son

THE FIRST TWO PSALMS COVER A LOT OF GROUND AND SERVE AS AN INTRODUCTION INTO MUCH OF WHAT THE PSALMS, AND THE EXPERIENCE OF BEING HUMANS, ARE ABOUT

1 Why do the nations conspire and the peoples plot in vain? 2 The kings of the earth rise up and the rulers band together against the Lord and against his anointed, saying, 3 "Let us break their chains and throw off their shackles."

4 The One enthroned in heaven laughs; the Lord scoffs at them. 5 He rebukes them in his anger and terrifies them in his wrath, saying, 6 "I have installed my king on Zion, my holy mountain."

7 I will proclaim the Lord's decree: He said to me, "You are my son; today I have become your father. 8 Ask me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession.

9 You will break them with a rod of iron; you will dash them to pieces like pottery." 10 Therefore, you kings, be wise; be warned, you rulers of the earth. 11 Serve the Lord with fear and celebrate his rule with trembling.

12 Kiss his son, or he will be angry and your way will lead to your destruction, for his wrath can flare up in a moment. Blessed are all who take refuge

TO SUM THIS UP: THERE IS NO POINT STANDING AGAINST THE LORD!

WHO IS THIS, THE KING OF GLORY?

We need to have confidence in who it is that we serve, worship and take refuge in

No plan can oppose Him and prevail

The authority, the glory, the worship - they all belong to The Lord!

NATIONS, KINGS AND RULERS OF THIS WORLD CAN TRY AND STAND AGAINST THE LORD AND HIS ANOINTED - BUT DOING SO IS LAUGHABLE!

TAKE-SCOFF

In Psalm 1 we are told not to sit with the 'scoffers'
In Psalm 2 we see The Lord 'scoffing' at the nations
and rulers who try and stand against Him and His
anointed - resistance is futile!

What seems like earthly victory is momentary and is nothing compared to the will and purpose of God

27 For the Lord Almighty has purposed, and who can thwart him? His hand is stretched out, and who can turn it back?

WE CAN TRUST IN THE MIGHT OF THE LORD INDIVIDUALLY AND AS COMMUNITY

GOD IS IN CHARGE

There is no circumstance in our lives - past, present or future - that is beyond of the Lord's ability and authority to work for His good purpose (Ro. 8:28)

What the enemy means for evil, The Lord works for good (Gen. 50:20)

No weapon created to bring God's people down is going to do so (Is. 54:17)

WITH GOD, EVEN THAT WHICH LOOKS LIKE DEFEAT ENDS UP IN HIS VICTORY

27 Indeed Herod and Pontius Pilate met together with the Gentiles and the people of Israel in this city to conspire against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed. 28 They did what your power and will had decided beforehand should happen. THE GREATEST EVER PET TWIST: EVEN WHEN THE NATIONS SEEMED TO HAVE THEIR WAY AGAINST THE LORD'S ANOINTED ONE, GOD WAS STILL IN CHARGE!

KING INCARNATE

The death, resurrection and reign of Christ give us the perfect example of God's redemptive power

The devil and the nations of the world conspired to destroy the Lord's anointed, but the Lord scoffs!

In God's redemptive plan from before time began Christ would always become the risen Lord of all

13 I charge you in the presence of God, who gives life to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who in his testimony before Pontius Pilate made the good confession, 14 to keep the commandment unstained and free from reproach until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ,

15 which he will display at the proper time—he who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords, 16 who alone has immortality, who dwells in unapproachable light, whom no one has ever seen or can see. To him be honour and eternal dominion. Amen.

THE LORD HAS ANOINTED HIS KING IN ZION!

THE SON

The Lord identifies Christ in this psalm as 'my son'

The 'Christ' means 'Messiah' or 'Anointed One' who is chosen and set apart by the Lord

The echo of this rings out at the baptism of Jesus in Matthew

16 And when Jesus was baptised, immediately he went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming to rest on him; 17 and behold, a voice from heaven said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

We shall not greatly err in our summary of this sublime Psalm if we call it THE PSALM OF MESSIAH THE PRINCE; for it sets forth, as in a wondrous vision, the tumult of the people against the Lord's anointed, the determinate purpose of God to exalt his own Son, and the ultimate reign of that Son over all his enemies.

ETERNAL KING

Jesus is the Holy King Eternal - who was, and is, and is to come

The nations and Kings are implored to 'be wise, serve the Lord and celebrate His rule' - oh how rulers of the world need this truth now!

Have you 'installed' Jesus as your King?

BLESSED, HAPPY, JOYFUL, ENVIABLE ARE THOSE WHO HAVE TRUSTED IN THE KING
